#### "A Bylaw to Establish Fees and Charges for Services and Information"

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Community Charter*, Section 194 (1) states that Council may, by bylaw impose a fee in respect of (a) all or part of a service of the municipality or provision of information, therefore, Council of the District of Tumbler Ridge, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT fees levied by the District of Tumbler Ridge for admissions, applications received, services rendered and goods supplied shall in accordance with the following Schedules "A" "B" and "C" which are attached to and form part of this Bylaw are hereby imposed.
- 2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as "District of Tumbler Ridge Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 623, 2017".
- 3. "District of Tumbler Ridge Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 315, 1993" is hereby REPEALED in its entirety.
- 4. This bylaw shall take effect upon adoption by the affirmative vote of a majority of Council present at the meeting at which the vote is taken.
