**“A Bylaw to Establish Fees and Charges for Services and
Information”**

WHEREAS, pursuant to the *Community Charter*, Section 194 (1) states that Council may, by bylaw impose a fee in respect of (a) all or part of a service of the municipality or provision of information, therefore, Council of the District of Tumbler Ridge, in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT fees levied by the District of Tumbler Ridge for admissions, applications received, services rendered and goods supplied shall in accordance with the following Schedules “A” “B” and “C” which are attached to and form part of this Bylaw are hereby imposed.
2. This Bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “*District of Tumbler Ridge Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 623, 2017*”.
3. “*District of Tumbler Ridge Fees and Charges Bylaw No. 315, 1993*” is hereby REPEALED in its entirety.
4. This bylaw shall take effect upon adoption by the affirmative vote of a majority of Council present at the meeting at which the vote is taken.

Fees and Charges Amendment Bylaw No. 754, 2025

The following new sections are added to the bylaw:

Waivers and Reductions

- a. Council may, by resolution or in accordance with the terms and conditions of an applicable District policy, waive or reduce any fee or charge established in this bylaw.
- b. Where authorized by Council policy, the Chief Administrative Officer, or another designated director, may approve waivers or reductions of fees and charges established in this bylaw, provided such waivers or reductions comply with the criteria set out in the applicable policy and do not exceed the limits established by Council.
- c. Where Council approves a written agreement with a non-commercial organization, including but not limited to government agencies, educational institutions, or registered non-profit societies, any fees or charges established in this bylaw may be waived or reduced in accordance with the terms of that agreement.

The balance of Bylaw No. 623, 2017 cited as “District of Tumbler Ridge Fees and Charges for Services and Information Bylaw No. 623, 2017” not amended by this Bylaw shall remain in full force and effect.
