About us:

The District of Tumbler Ridge is a great place to live and work. Our operations are diverse, requiring a variety of positions as well as different levels of skill and education.

About the role:

Under the direction of the Roads Foreman, the Heavy Equipment Operator (I) will perform a variety of general and specific duties while playing a crucial role in maintaining and enhancing the infrastructure of the community. Operating heavy machinery, the Heavy Equipment Operator I will contribute to the construction, repair, and maintenance of roads and other public facilities.

Responsibilities:

- Operate various heavy machinery such as, vactors, loaders, and graders to perform tasks including excavation, grading, and material handling.
- From time to time will cover operating the Light equipment fleet.
- Assist in the construction and maintenance of roads, sidewalks, drainage systems, and other public infrastructure projects.
- Ensure compliance with safety protocols and regulations while operating equipment to prevent accidents and injuries.
- Perform daily maintenance checks on machinery, including inspecting fluids, and identifying any potential issues to ensure optimal performance and longevity of equipment.
- Collaborate with other department staff to coordinate tasks effectively and achieve project goals within specified timelines.
- Maintain accurate records of work performed, equipment usage, and maintenance activities.
- Identify and report equipment malfunctions or maintenance needs promptly to minimize downtime and maximize productivity.
- Able to follow company procedures and adhere to company standards, proper and safe usage of all tools and equipment.
- Assist with manual labor tasks such as digging, lifting, and loading/unloading materials as needed.
- Collaborate with team members to coordinate work activities and prioritize tasks to meet project deadlines.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.

- REQUIRED Class one (1) or three (3) with Air Brakes
 Endorsement or willing to obtain.
- PREFERRED Appropriate training and working knowledge.
- **PREFERRED** Minimum of two (2) years experience in a municipal public works environment.
